## Introduction

### Education and early career

His final year project was the design and CFD analysis of a solar car for the UTS team.

While studying, Lester gained valuable experience working in fan and blower design and manufacture, as well as in steelmaking and in international licensing and manufacture of garage doors and automatic openers. For three years, Lester later led teams of designers in locomotive and passenger train design and manufacture.
